Additional responsibilities include:

- Supporting the Marketing Manager with creation and execution of marketing for Ballet Jörgen's performances and touring;
- Marketing administration duties as needed;
- Supporting the Education Department with creation and execution of marketing plans for George Brown Dance, Summer Dance, Virtual Dance Academy and other education related marketing.
